ORDINANCE NO. 2020 -08

An Ordinance Approving the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Form RD1940-1
Request for Obligation of Funds For the Purchase of a Fire Truck,
And Declaring it an Emergency

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to purchase a new fire truck for the fire department; and

WHEREAS, said Council deems it necessary to seek a grant and a loan from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) in order to purchase the fire truck

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

- 1: Council hereby approves the entering into of the USDA Form RD 1940-1 Request for Obligation of Funds attached hereto as Exhibit A to request obligation of the funds from USDA for both grant and loan funding for the purchase of a fire truck for the Village of Carrollton Fire Department.
- 2: William J. Stoneman, Mayor, and Mark A. Wells, Village Administrator, are hereby authorized to execute the Form RD 1940-1 Request For Obligation of Funds on behalf of the Village of Carrollton.
3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure funding for the purchase of a fire truck for the Village Fire Department and to meet the time deadlines for the application for funds in this funding cycle of the USDA, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
